The mochi is made by each team pounding steamed rice using the traditional wooden mallet (kine) into the stone mortar (usu). The completed displays were judged by shape, size, uniformity and overall craftsmanship. This was a pot luck event, however this year the Entry Fee for each team was to provide a sample dish of their favorite oshogatsu food with a short written description about the food item and fond memory about it or why it is your favorite.
